



ARTICLE 1 NAME

The name of the Club shall be "The Sydney Arrows Ice Racing Club" hereinafter referred to as "The Club". The Club is the Short Track Speed Skating division of the Sydney Ice Racing Club Inc. a club incorporated in the State of NSW using the Model Rules referred to in the Incorporation Act, 1984, clause 8.

ARTICLE 2 AFFILIATION

The Club shall be affiliated to the ISSA of NSW or its successors or assigns.

ARTICLE 3 MEMBERSHIP

Membership of the club is open to persons nominated by a financial member of the club approved by the committee of the club.

AMENDMENT

Membership of the club is open to persons nominated by a financial member of the club and approved by any other club affiliated to NSW ISSA or AAIRC. Should any member subsequently join another club their membership shall be terminate or transferred.

ARTICLE 4 OBJECTS

The objects of the Club shall be to promote the sport of Short Track Speed Skating among its members, and to extend its membership by such means as desirable, e.g. teaching, coaching and carrying out competitions among the members of the Club.

The Club shall not profit from these objectives.

ARTICLE 5 COLOURS

The colours which the Club members shall use as the racing uniform for the Club are NAVY BLUE, ORANGE (i.e. gold) and WHITE.

ARTICLE 6 ELEGIBILITY

The Club shall use, as its definition of eligibility to compete, the standard as laid down from time to time by the ISU or its successors and assigns.

ARTICLE 7 RULES FOR COMPETITIONS

1. Competitions closed to non-Club members

When the Club carries on competitions open only to members of the Club, then the racing rules set out from time to time, in the Regulations of the ISU, or its successors and assigns, shall be used to govern the conduct of those competitions.

2. Open Competitions

Should the Club wish to carry on competitions that are open to entry from speed skaters who are members from another club, whatever the affiliation of that Club may be, then the Club shall:

a) Seek sanction from the AAIRC Inc, or its successors and assigns to allow the skaters of the Club to compete should the non-members be from clubs outside NSW.

Note: Under no circumstances, shall skaters who are not members in good standing of a Member [i.e. Club] of the ISU or its successors and assigns be permitted to compete in competitions organised by the Club.

The Rules for Conduct of such competitions shall be those announced from time to time by the ISSA of NSW.

ARTICLE 8 HEADQUARTERS

The headquarters of the Club shall be the Canterbury Olympic Ice Rink or such other place as the members may decide from time to time, at a General Meeting of the Club.

ARTICLE 9 COACHING AND PRACTICE

The Club committee shall at each AGM of the Club appoint such individuals as may be necessary to be Coaches for the members of the Club. Coaching policies shall be set out by these Coaches, and be available for all members of the Club upon applications to the Club's committee.

The Club members shall refer to the Club coaches for standards of behaviour and skating at training sessions as organised by the Club. It is also mandatory that the skaters who are not members of the Club, but who are desiroius of participating in training times arranged by the Club, shall carry out their skating practice at the direction of the Club's coaches. This is necessary to ensure the safety of all who participate at Club practice sessions. In the event Club coaches are not available, the Club appointed Safety Officers will be responsible for conduct on the ice.

ARTICLE 10 AMENDMENTS

These By-Laws and Objects may be amended by the Club's Committee at a properly constituted meeting of the Committee, always provided that any proposed amendment shall be the subject of a properly set out notice of motion, with adequate notice having been given to the Club's Committee.
